Our mental health programs in Liberia.

St. Benedict Menni Health Centre operates in Monrovia under the auspices of the National Catholic Health Council (NCHC) and the Ministry of Health of Liberia.

It comprises two facilities: the **Health Centre**, where emergency, consultation, maternity, vaccination and laboratory services are provided, and the **Mental Health Centre**.

In 2017, Sisters Hospitallers, with the WHO and other partners' financial support, opened this facility as a collaborative project named **We Are Like You**, which aims to improve the well-being of women living with mental illness

Our core objective is to restore dignity, improve physical and psycho-social well-being, and reintegrate our patients into the community through a multi-disciplinary approach.

The Mental Health Centre offers **two main programs**:

- The Step Down Unit is a psychiatric mid-stay unit.
- Substance Use Disorders (SUD) Program.

All programs are focused on the rehabilitation of persons living with various mental disorders through psychotherapy, pharmacotherapy and occupational therapy as main tools.
